Goal

To implement Validation recommendation-realign Year level scope and sequences and develop more cohesive RE units by creating deeper understanding around the 'big ideas' in RE curriculum

Strategies

- APRE to collaborate with EORE Stephen Locke to create and deliver PD around 'Big Ideas' in RE curriculum to teaching staff.
- APRE to work alongside year level teams to review and improve scope and sequences in alignment with 'Big Ideas' in RE curriculum.

Goal

For selected staff to be exposed to MJR way of life by attending an interstate MJR conference at St Kevin's School on the Gold Coast.

Strategies

- Notification to staff who will attend conference.
- The team to meet and plan presentation for wider audience.

Excellent learning and teaching: Grow engagement, progress, achievement and wellbeing for each student

Goal

By the end of 2017, through a school wide consistent approach of expected and effective practices in the teaching of reading, 95% of our Year 3, 4, 5 students will show at least 12 months growth evident in the results of Pat R normed sampled expectations for these three years.

Strategies

- PLL to work in years 3 and 4 Literacy Blocks to model, co-teach and observe effective pedagogies in reading and writing.
- Staff Professional Learning
- Use data to inform learning.
- Provide LNE teachers to enhance literacy and numeracy.

Strategies
